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## **DON'T BREAK THE BANK – TAKE AN OVERLAND TOUR WITH ACACIA AND PAY-AS-YOU-GO IN AFRICA**

In addition, where most holidays leave travellers out of pocket on their return home any spare cash left over at the end of Acacia's overland tours is redistributed amongst the group.*

Costs involve a payment for the tour itself with an additional mandatory basic local payment paid at the start of the tour covering food, camping and normally at least one major game park. This in addition to the flexible payment option allows travellers to save for their dream holiday in Africa right up until the day they leave the UK. It also gives people the same freedom as independent travellers, planning additional excursions and activities as they travel through the continent. However, when overlanding with Acacia, experts in Africa for over 16 years, all the hassle is taken out of the equation and all the best sites are included in the tour.

More than just a sedate safari covering the diverse landscapes and wildlife of Africa, the Desert Tracker is action packed. One of Acacia's most popular overland tours, the budget friendly escape covers South Africa, Namibia, Botswana and Zambia in only 19-days. Complete with some world breaking highlights, the tour features the Fish River Canyon, the world's second largest canyon and Namib Naukluft National Park, a location which boasts the worlds highest sand dunes (up to 300m). The Desert Tracker also includes Etosha National Park a 20,000 sq km reserve, with camping near floodlit waterholes offering excellent opportunities for wildlife viewing alongside morning and afternoon game drives. The adventure continues in Botswana adventurers exploring the wetlands of the Okavango Delta before heading north to Chobe National Park. A final animal extravaganza – the park is home to the largest population of elephants in Africa best viewed on a fish eagle cruise, these huge mammals often found lazing at the waters edge. Zambia is the end of the trail for 'budget overlanders' with gorge swinging, scenic flights, white water rafting and sunset cruises making up only a small number of the many optional activities on offer around the Victoria Falls.
